Article I. The name of the organization shall be The American Dairymen s Association. Art. II. The Officers of the Association shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. Art. III. The President, First Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, shall constitute the Executive Board of the Association. Art. IV. The Officers of the Association shall be elected at the regular annual meeting, and shall retain their offices until their successors are chosen. Art. V. The...
